

Awana Game Circle Installation Instructions

Recommended Supplies:

- a) Roll of tape or Velcro® for each color (red, blue, green, yellow, white)
- b) Two measuring tapes (at least one 100' tape)
- c) Sidewalk chalk
- d) 5 pieces of tape or Velcro® of each color (Red, Blue, Green, Yellow) – 6" long
- e) 4 pieces of white tape or Velcro® - 18" long
- f) 1 piece of tape or Velcro® of each color (Red, Blue, Green, Yellow) - 4' long

Installation Instructions:

1. Measure 20' off of the center line of the room (normally the half court mark) at three different points on the same line. Mark the points with chalk.
2. Lay down the first color connecting the three points (for this instruction, it will be the green line), anchoring the tape on one side, rolling it out the entire length of the line, aligning the tape before securing it to the floor.
3. From the left side of the green line (facing out from the center), lay down a measuring tape 40' out for the blue line. From the right side of the green line, measure diagonally 56' 7" to intersect the first measuring tape. Align the two tapes to meet (should be at 40' and 56' 7") and mark this as the Red-Blue corner of the red line with chalk. While the diagonal measuring tape is laid out, mark the halfway point at 28' 3 ½" with chalk.
4. Lay down the Blue line from the green line to this newly marked corner.
5. Reverse the measuring tapes to determine the Yellow-Red corner (should be at 40' and 56' 7"), marking with chalk. Verify that the two edges of the Red line are 40' apart. While the diagonal measuring tape is laid out, mark the halfway point at 28' 3 ½" with chalk to verify the center of the circle.
6. Lay down the yellow line from the green line to this newly marked corner.
7. Lay down the red line between the blue and yellow lines at the marked points.
8. Lay tape from each of the corners to the center point for each of the four colors (see diagram for correct color layout).
9. Measure from the center point down each color diagonal and mark the following points (with a mark and the number): 5', 7', 8', 9', 10', 11', 12', and 15' (this shows where lines intersect the diagonal – the 15' mark is optional since the circle is laid down with the measuring tape).
10. Lay the white circle at the 15' measurement. Have one person hold the measuring tape end at the center, a second person holding the tape roll and a third person holding the measuring tape while securing each section of tape to ensure that it remains circular.
11. Lay down the center square at the 7' marks (color should match the outer square).
12. Lay down the 6" color strips centered on the color diagonals at the 5', 9', 10', 11' & 12' marks.
13. Lay down the 4' color strip centered on the color diagonal at the 8' mark
14. From the intersection of the color diagonal and the white circle, measure 4' to the left (facing out from the center) and lay down the 18" white strip extending away from the center starting on the white circle.

Awana® Game Square

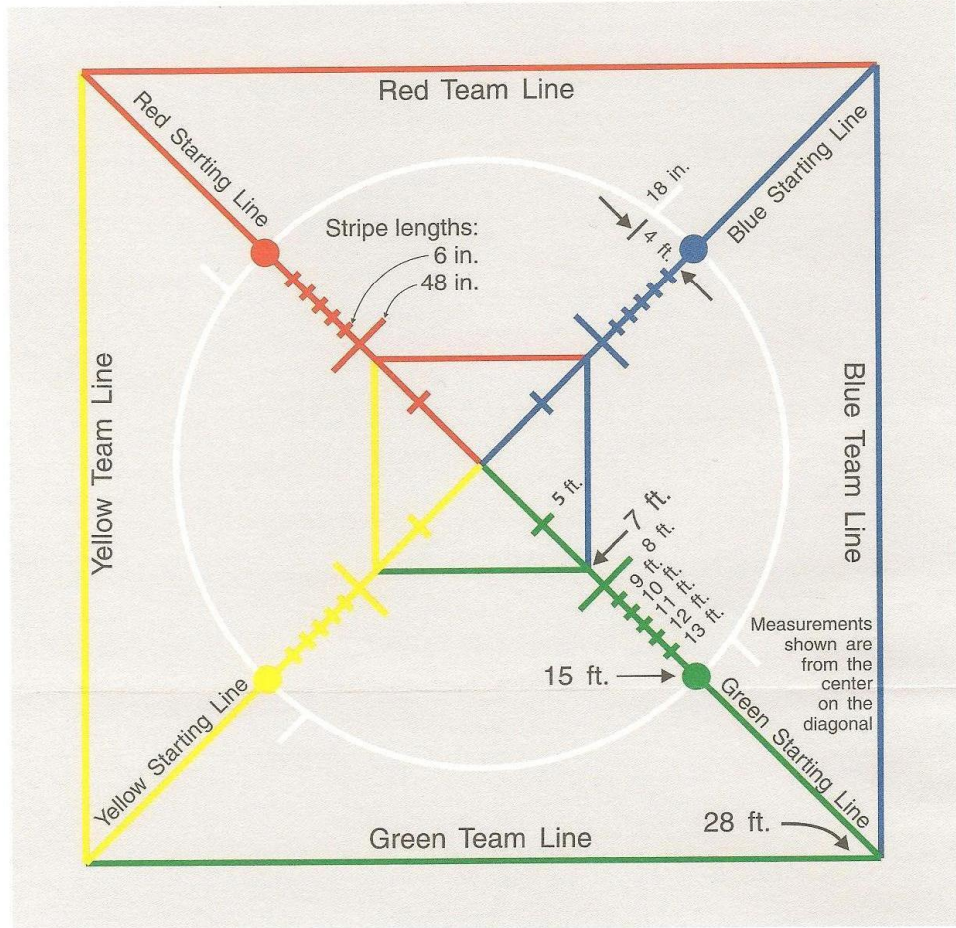
The Game Square is 37-40 feet with a 30-foot diameter circle. Each team is designated by a color and occupies a quarter-circle and one side of that square.

For proper placement of floor tapes, please refer to Awana Game Square diagram at right. Read all instructions carefully for proper preparation of floor surface.

For brand new gymnasiums, Awana recommends painting the lines on the floor. If you prefer not to use paint, Awana recommends permanent tape.

When applying permanent floor tape, be sure floor surface is free from dirt, waxes, oil sealers, etc. Consider "stripping" floor or tile surface where tape is to be applied.

Note: Many clubs that wish to cut down on maintenance and reduce the noise level are adding gym carpeting with inlaid Game Square. Call Customer Service for a list of suppliers.



*Teams stand outside the Game Square along the line of their team color. In relay games, the center pin and beanbag are placed in the very center. Each team member, in turn, runs from his **starting** pin around the complete circle, **past** his starting pin and along his color diagonal into center of circle for center pin or beanbag.*

PERMANENT VINYL FLOOR TAPE

Premium-quality for use on tile, wood and concrete floors. Sold in single rolls 1½" x 35 yds. (White is 1" x 36 yds.) Put a clear sealer over the tape after installation to make it last longer. One roll of each color is sufficient to lay out an entire Awana Game Square.

Designed for removal after use. Especially suitable for rented gyms or AwanaGames™. Sold in single rolls 1½" x 60 yds. (White is 1" x 60 yds.) One roll of each color is sufficient to lay out an entire Awana Game Square. Cannot be reapplied.

VELCRO® FLOOR TAPE

For churches with carpeted game floors. If church carpeting has a "return loop" and not cut pile (loose strands), this product will hold tight. Comes in 36-yard rolls, 1½" wide. Can be removed. Durable. One roll of each color is sufficient to lay out an entire Awana Game Square.
